ARE YOU SQUAWKING ?

Make sure you're transponder (and Mode C) is ON on every flight, whether or not you're talking to ATC. This could prevent a mid-air collision for two reasons: ATC may point you out as traffic for an unseen plane that maneuvers to miss you, or an unseen TCAS or TCAD equipped aircraft may "see" you and take evasive action. If this practice saves your life just one time it's worth it!
