A380 COMING TO OSHKOSH JULY 28—31!



For the first time in North America, the general public will have a chance to take walk-through tours of the interior of an Airbus A380, the largest passenger aircraft in the world, when the airplane visits EAA AirVenture Oshkosh. AirVenture attendees will have the opportunity to walk through both the main deck and the full-length upper deck. Information panels along the circuit will provide insights into the aircraft's design, engineering, and construction - and the international collaboration required to build it. _____

The AirVenture dates are Monday, **July 27** through Sunday, **August 2**. The A380 is scheduled to arrive Tuesday, **July 28** and will start the Tuesday Air Show. OSHKOSH WORK WEEKEND

The pace has definitely quickened on the Oshkosh AirVenture grounds as the weather turns summery and more volunteers arrive each day. One of the most visible changes to the convention grounds for AirVenture 2009 will be the addition of way finding towers.

This year four towers extending 54 feet above the ground and four smaller 8 foot towers are nearing completion in the Fabrication Shop by EAA staff members and volunteers. Each of the large towers, weighing several tons, is made up of almost one thousand individual pieces of steel welded together by hand. Once the towers are in place, they will be painted and covered

with colorful signs making them highly visible to AirVenture visitors. When erected on the AirVenture grounds, the larger towers will have a hinged base to they can be raised during the convention or lowered to meet FAA requirements during the remainder of the year.
